**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cornelius has provided citizens with emergency communication services for thirteen years commencing the first week of March, 1993 and E-911 services for ten years commencing the first week of March, 1996; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and

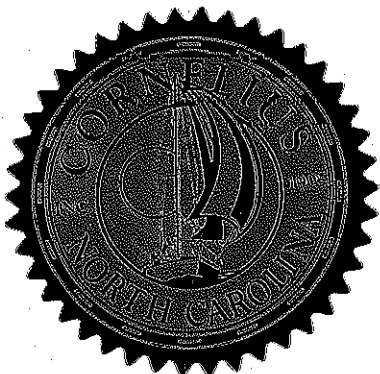
**WHEREAS**, the North Mecklenburg Communications Center has provided prompt, courteous, calming, and reassuring voices to almost 1 million requests for service from the public during the existence of this service; and



**WHEREAS**, the services of Public Safety Telecommunicators are a "silent service" and their duties are seldom observed by the public.
